

NAMS Fellow Recognition Requirements

Election as Fellow shall be in recognition of both “service to NAMS” and “highly significant professional accomplishment in the membrane field”. A nominee for election of NAMS Fellow should have demonstrated long term excellence in membrane engineering and practice and has been a member of NAMS for at least 10 years. Nominator must be a NAMS Member. Current Board members cannot nominate fellows or be named fellows. A maximum of two Fellow recognitions per year is expected. Nomination deadline is October 1. Nomination package containing the nomination form, CV, and supporting letters should be sent as one pdf file to the Fellow Selection Committee Chair, D. Bhattacharyya (db@uky.edu). All nominees will be informed of the Board’s decisions by January 31.
